

Santa Fe Philippines goes Marine!!!

Recently, Santa Fe Philippines Special Projects has teamed up with CTSI - Guam in organizing and handling 4x40ø Flat Racks carrying Mooring Buoys (5MT each), Anchors (5MT each), Dead Man Sinkers (10MT each), giant Swivel Shackles and 12ø diameter Chains. These items are for Shell Pacific bound for Koror, Palau.

Originating from a beachfront in Bataan (some 4 hours drive north of Manila), items were loaded in a chartered barge. Looks simple, is it? The site has got no road access and more so on soft sand and on shallow water. Exciting??? The crew needs to wait for high tide before they can actually load and depart.
